Camino Real Regional Utility Authority is requesting the Purchasing Department for an emergency procurement of **Sulzer-ABS XFP206J-CB2-PE350/6, 8-inch submersible pump with quick ship-option.**

Written justification of the basis for the emergency:

13-1-127. Emergency procurement; required conditions; limitations; notice.

A. The state purchasing agent or a central purchasing office may only make an emergency procurement when the service, construction or item of tangible personal property procured:

(1) is needed immediately to:

(a) control a serious threat to public health, welfare, safety or property caused by a flood, fire, epidemic, riot, act of terrorism, equipment failure or similar event; or

(b) plan or prepare for the response to a serious threat to public health, welfare, safety or property caused by a flood, fire, epidemic, riot, act of terrorism, equipment failure or similar event; and

(2) cannot be acquired through normal procurement methods

CRRUA is requesting an emergency purchase for a pump at View point Lift Station. Invoice Attached is from Falcon for a Sulzer Pump. The reason for the emergency request is to prevent an environmental situation at the CRRUA North Plant. View Point Lift station should have 2 pumps at all times, should 1 pump fail there is a backup to keep wastewater pumping into the North Plant. This purchase will fix the pump which is down. These items are an emergency purchase for the safety and well-being of CRRUA employees and the Sunland Park Community. Doña County Purchasing Department confirmed with Sulzer Ltd., Falcon Environmental is the exclusive representative for Sulzer-ABS XFP206J-CB2-PE350/6 for our region.
