- 1. Integrate language justice principles so that all voices can be heard and prioritized.
- 2. Create online spaces for individuals to secure information about major events/activities in their community.
- 3. Manage a feedback loop to hear the concerns and strategies from residents.
- 4. Complete all measures under the Strategic Plan's Transparency For You and Inclusivity and Respect sections.
- 5. Carry out a One-Year Community Implementation Plan of the Strategic Plan.

Goal Two: Improve wellness and wellbeing.

Adopted Vital Conditions and Urgent Services: Basic Needs for Health & Safety; Addiction Treatment; Unemployment and Food Assistance; Acute Care for Illness and Injury

#### **Basic Needs for Health and Safety Strategies**

- 1. Improve community resiliency and health outcomes by addressing the social determinants of health in rural communities (cross-cutting strategy for Unemployment and Food Assistance).
- 2.Improve self-managed care behaviors for adults with diabetes and improve preventative behaviors for people with pre-diabetes.
- 3. Provide efficient and quality services for safety and education around animal welfare.
- 4. Ensure excellent and responsive fire and rescue services across the County.
- 5. Increase accessibility of parks, trails, and thriving communities.

#### **Addiction Treatment Strategies**

- 1. Reduce/prevent substance use disorders and the impact of alcohol on health outcomes and public safety through public education, Driving While Intoxicated offender services, and substance use treatment.
- 2. Reduce opioid overdose, both fatal and non-fatal, within Doña Ana County.

#### **Acute Care for Illness and Injury Strategy**

1. Improve access to primary, dental, and behavioral care for people who are un/under-insured and work with safety-net care providers to improve the quality of the local healthcare delivery system.

Adopted Vital Conditions and Urgent Services: Natural Thriving World, Reliable Transportation, Meaningful Wealth and Work

#### Natural Thriving World / Reliable Transportation

- 1. Prioritize key infrastructure to best attract business and address community needs.
- 2. Create equitable access to electric vehicle fueling infrastructure.
- 3. Facilitate the safe and efficient movement of people, freight, and emergency operations (*cross-cutting solution for Reliable Transportation*).
- 4. Be prepared for any threat to our community.

#### Meaningful Wealth & Work (Internal strategies for Doña Ana County employees/infrastructure)

- 1. Launch an economic development department.
- 2. Support the professional growth of Doña Ana County employees.
- 3. Provide Doña Ana County employees with a strong administrative backbone to support quality work.
- 4. Increase digital literacy at the County through a certification process for department directors and administrators to navigate their online work environment successfully.
- 5. Improve the brand recognition and integrity of Doña Ana County.

As a County, there are Vital Conditions we can influence and improve. There are Urgent Services that we can fund and be a bridge builder for our community. This is our way forward.


